

ACT/SAT/PSAT/AP and College Application Fee Waiver Request

You have requested a testing waiver for your child, but she/he is not on the direct certification list provided by the Child Nutrition Program. In order to qualify for a waiver, you will need to provide your 2016 IRS Tax Return to Baton Rouge High. The ruling below allows us to ask for records only if the parent volunteers the information.

*LSA-R.S. 17:3914 C (h), specifically prohibits a school official from requiring the collection of family income information **unless it is voluntarily disclosed**. That said, failure to disclose where required may result in the student being denied the benefit.*

A student's **eligibility can be primarily determined** using the levels for reduced lunch listed in the USDA income eligibility chart. Eligibility for reduced lunch is listed below and is your total income before deductions (Line 22 on the IRS 1040 form).
